SUBJECT: 2004 Title 10 Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) Sergeant Promotion Board Results

1. Reference:

a. 2004 Title 10 AGR Enlisted Promotion Board Announcement dated 20 October 2003 with corrections effective 17 November 2003.

b. NGR 600-200, Chapter 11

2. The 2004 Title 10 Sergeant promotion board was conducted the week of 26 July 2004, at Jefferson Plaza 1, Arlington, Virginia and considered three eligible specialists currently on Title 10 orders. The following information and forms are provided:

a. Enclosure 1 – Demographic Report

b. Enclosure 2 – 2004 Sergeant Promotion List

3. The Sergeant Promotion Board considered three eligible specialists who are listed according to their Primary Military Occupational Specialty (PMOS) ranked from the greatest number of points to the least within each PMOS.

4. Promotions are based upon the needs of the Title 10 AGR Program and total promotion points awarded.

5. Additional promotion opportunities may become available during the term of the promotion list based upon eligibility and availability per NGR 600-200, chapter 11. Placement on the list, as well as the order in which a soldier is listed should not be construed as an immediate potential for promotion. Soldiers assigned a sequence number will be given an approximate effective promotion date, usually corresponding to the promotion list release date. All soldiers who receive a sequence number must be in a promotable status to be promoted. Those given a sequence number who are not in a promotable status will not be promoted until they are in a promotable status, per NGR 600-200, Chapter 11.
